Track 1: Police Officers, Emerg. Track 2: Fire Department / Hazmat Responders: (One) 6-hour training session offered each day 8a-3p (arrive by 745a) that includes both hands on and classroom modules: Rail Car & Locomotive Anatomy, Tank Truck Emergencies, Fuming Acid Emergencies, Rail Car Capping Kits "C & Midland" with Leak Mitigation, Grounding & Bonding for Hazmat, and Pipe Line Awareness and Emergency Response.
